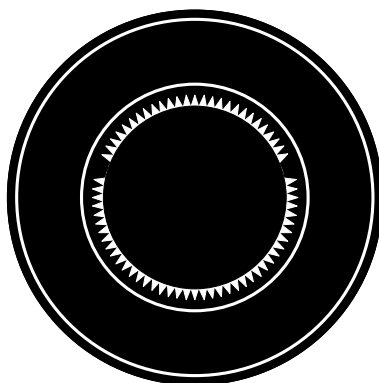

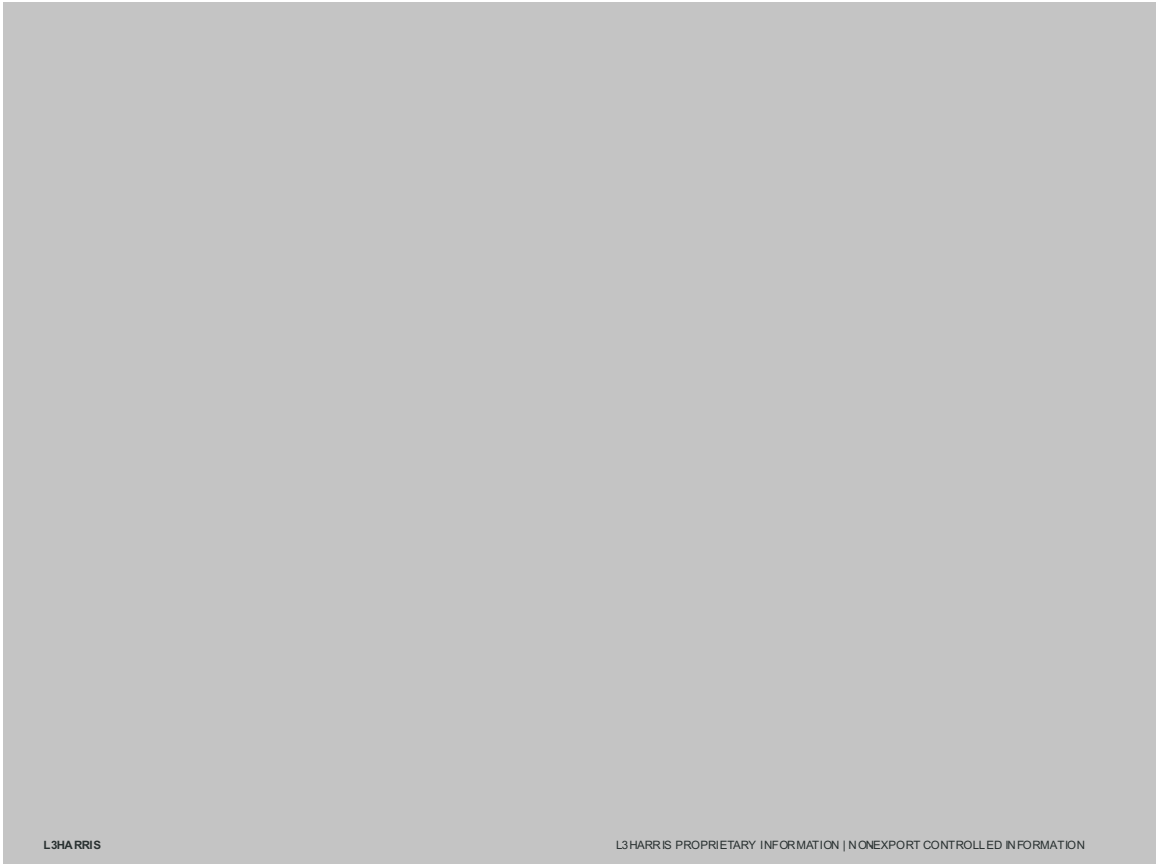

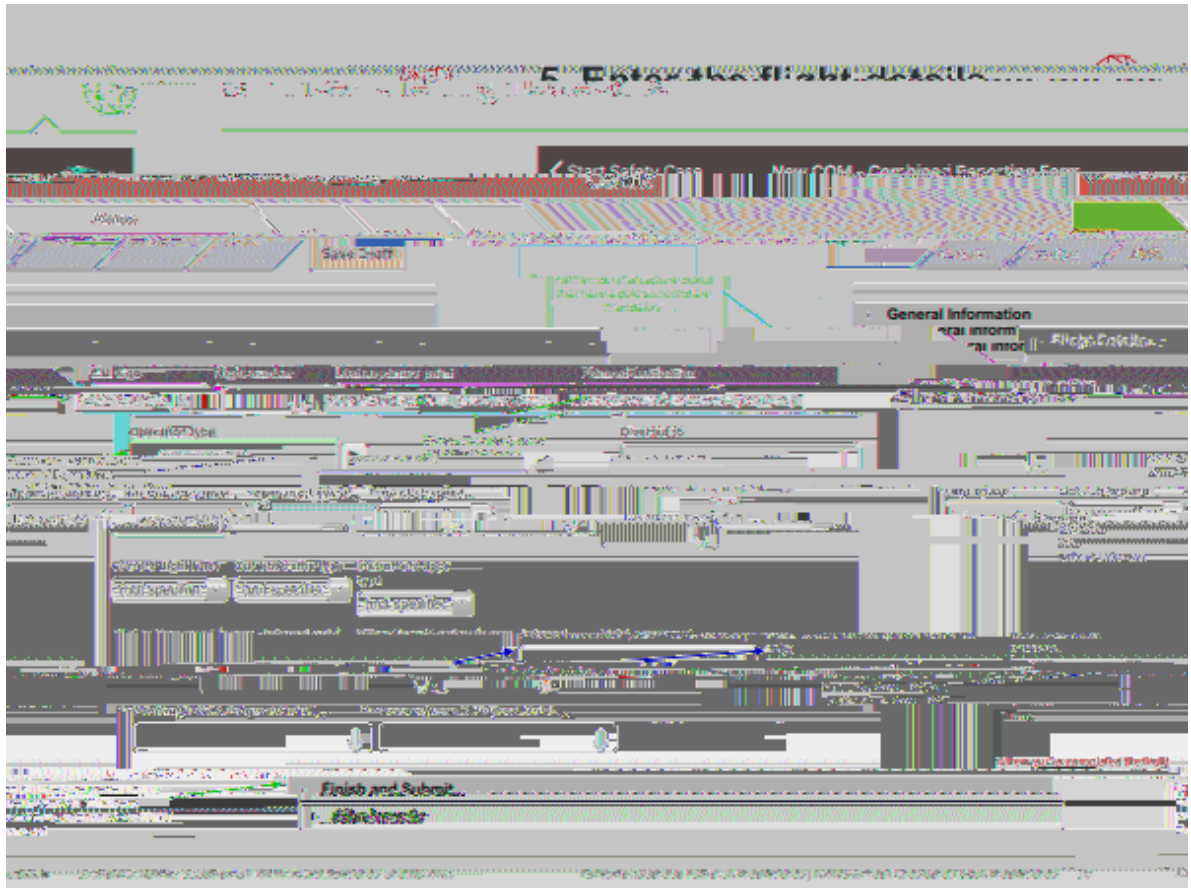

ATIS

ATIS (Automated Terminal Information System) is a self-service broadcast system that provides pilots with current information about the airport. This includes information about runway status, taxiway status, wind direction and speed, visibility, and other important details. Pilots use ATIS to receive this information before or after takeoff and landing. It is a critical part of the pre-flight and arrival/departure process.

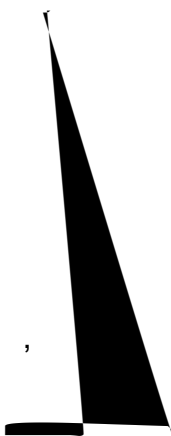
